

Code of Conduct

Being a part of the Tambelin Independent School community involves rights and responsibilities for each individual student as follows:

1. I have the right to obtain maximum benefit from all lessons and classes – other students will not deprive me of this right by their behaviour.

I have the responsibility to co-operate with teachers and other students and not to interfere with other students' right to learn.

2. I have the right to expect others will treat me with respect, politeness and consideration. I have the responsibility to treat all members of the school community and visitors with respect, politeness and consideration.

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3. I have the right to expect a school environment that is free from bullying/harassment and harmful or offensive behaviour; and supported in dealing with people who are responsible for such behaviour.

I have the responsibility not to bully or harass others with harmful or offensive behaviour and to support others experiencing this inappropriate behaviour by speaking out against this behaviour.

4. I have the right to expect that I will be safe at school.

I have the responsibility to follow instructions promptly and obey school rules.

5. I have the right to expect my property to be safe

I have the responsibility not to steal damage or interfere with school and others property.

I understand and accept this "Code of Conduct" as a positive basis for my interactions with my peers, teachers and guests of Tambelin Independent School and am willing to accept my responsibility for my behaviours. I am also willing to speak out against bullying and harassment.
